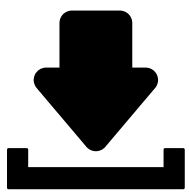


How to save your design practice over 100 hours a week with Excitech DOCS*

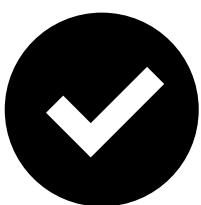
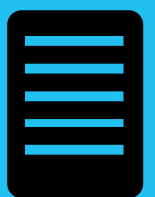
Whether you carry out tasks like transmittals and printing from Revit because you are contractually required or simply as best practice, the time and effort required to complete them should not be underestimated.

We spoke to 15 design practices who work on an average of 20 projects per week, to see how long they were taking to complete every day tasks and how much time they could save with our document management system Excitech DOCS.



Reduce the time you waste assembling transmittals by **13 hours** a week

Cut down the time you lose filling in data by **8 hours** a week



Decrease the time you spend approving documents by **21 hour** a week

Save **25 hours** a week printing from Revit (DWG, PDF, DWF)



Reduce the time you spend searching for files by **47 hours** a week

This graph shows how long each of the above tasks took to complete with and without Excitech DOCS. *Figures are dependent on the size of practice and number of projects worked on per year.
